

Regular Meeting
February 15, 2018

The Macon County Board of Commissioners held a regular meeting on Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. with Commission Chairman George, Commissioner Davis, Commissioner Haugabook, County Attorney Coogle, County Manager McDuffie and Deputy County Manager Starling in attendance. Commissioners Felton and Commissioner Melvin were absent.

Chairman George called the meeting to order and opened with a prayer.

Commissioner Haugabook made the motion to add under new business 6.2 Appointment to Development Authority Board, seconded by Commissioner Davis and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Davis made the motion to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2018 meeting as presented, seconded by Commissioner Haugabook and carried unanimously.

Chairman George reported that the Board had received a letter from the American Red Cross with statistical information on Macon County: (blood donations, disaster responses, etc.).

Commissioner Haugabook made the motion to submit the following bridges for consideration on the Low Impact Bridge Program, seconded by Commissioner Davis and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Davis made the motion to accept the City of Marshallville's appointee Valery Davis to the Macon County Development Authority Board, seconded by Commissioner Haugabook and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Haugabook made the motion to approve the Resolution to move into Executive Session to discuss disciplinary action and legal matters, seconded by Commissioner Davis and carried unanimously.

The Board reconvened the meeting after the Executive Session and Chairman George reported the County Manager had been instructed to take appropriate action on the disciplinary matter. The County Attorney was instructed to contact the parties in the legal matter and respond to their proposal.
